

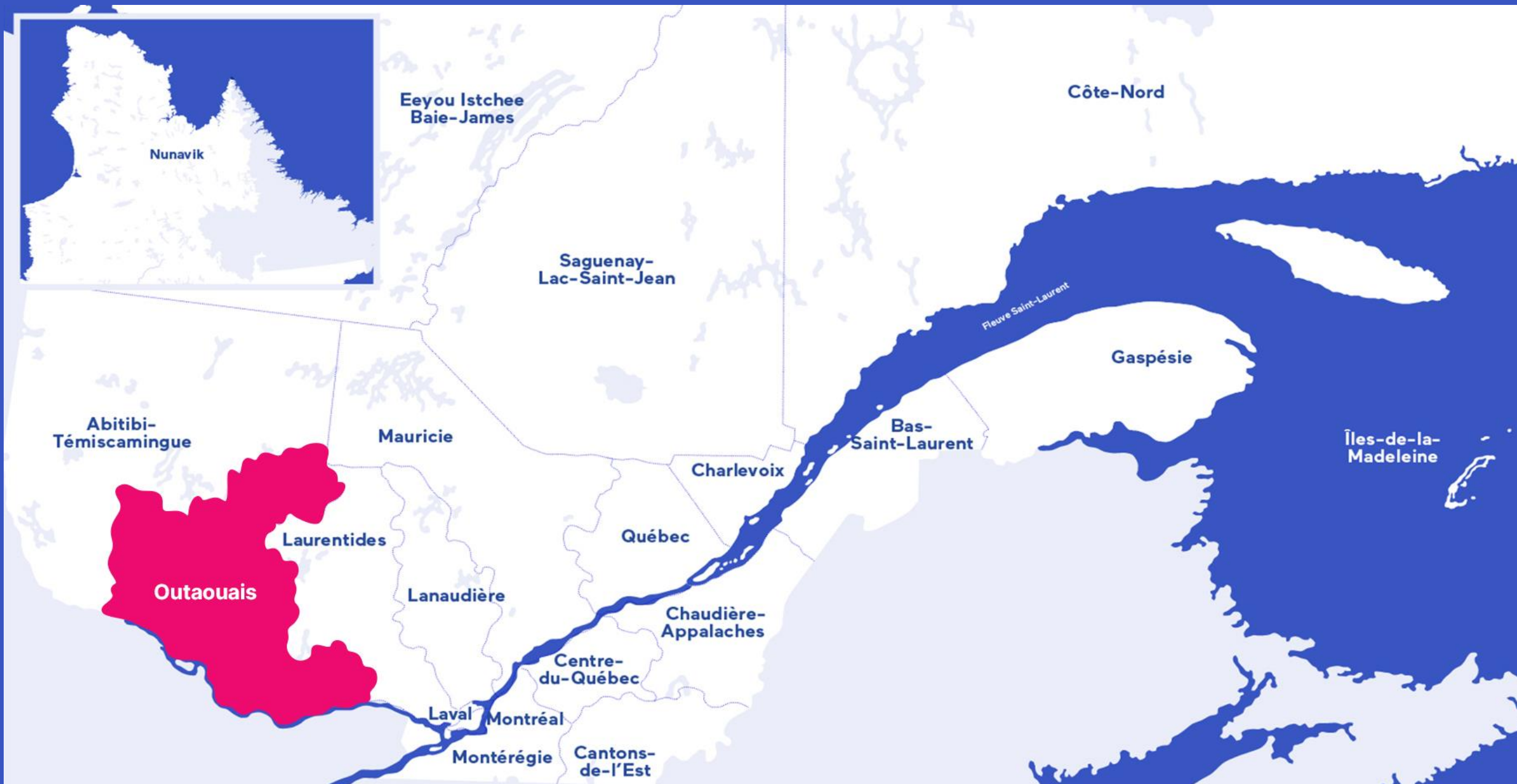

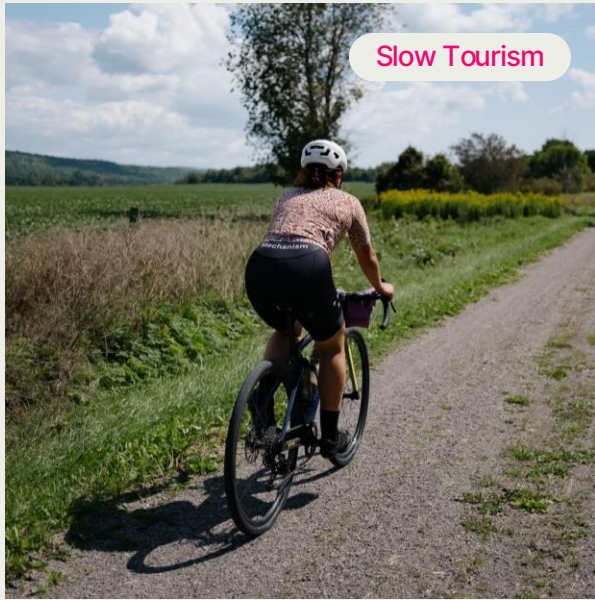




# PONTIAC

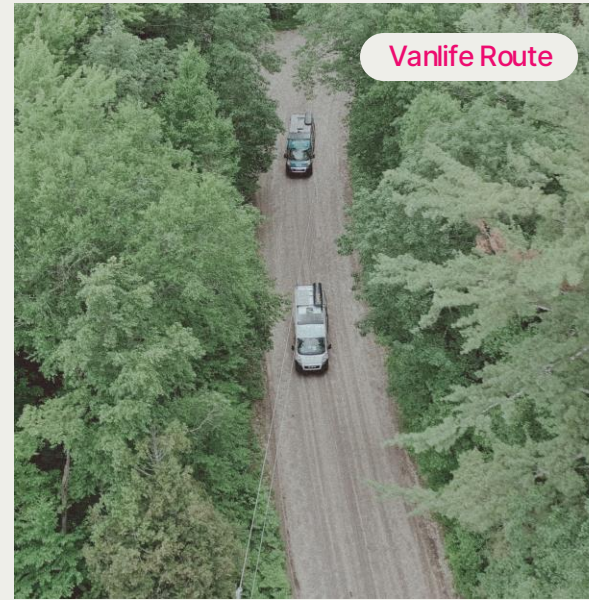




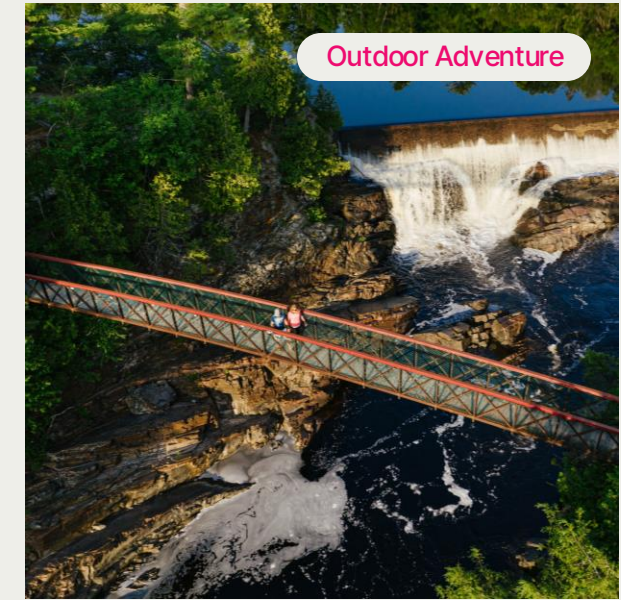

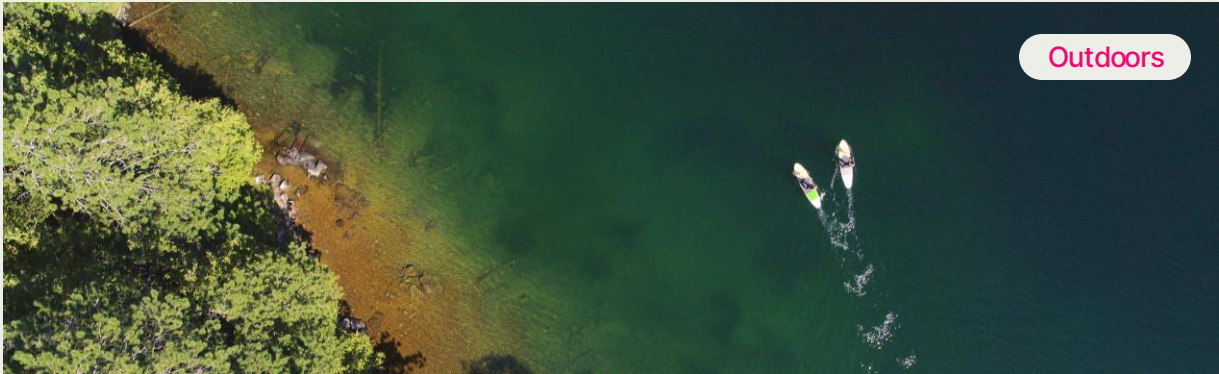
# VALLÉE-DE-LA-GATINEAU
